
The **MISSION** of the Forum is to support and advocate on behalf of the ESRD Networks in promoting methods to improve the quality of care to patients with renal disease.

Highlights from December 2022 Meeting



- Dr. Stephen Pastan and Dr. Priti Patel of Emory University presented on efforts to expand Medicaid coverage to undocumented patients.
- Dr. Henner shared changes in CMS leadership to include Melissa Dorsey now serving as Acting Director of the Division of Kidney Health. Dr. Shalon Quinn is now the Special Advisor for Data Initiatives.
- Dr. Andy Howard reviewed transplant metrics as of December 9, 2022, noting that is has been a good year for transplant overall with total transplants up from 2021, and steady growth each year driven by deceased donors. Unfortunately, living donations are still lagging. Waitlisting is up due to the efforts of the Networks and others.

COVID-19 Highlights



- Forum leadership continued to bring COVID priorities and concerns to CMS during monthly CMS/Forum leadership calls. Forum leaders provided updates on:
 - Rates of COVID testing for kidney patients
 - COVID positivity rates among kidney patients
 - Vaccination rates among kidney patients and dialysis staff
 - Kidney transplant and waitlist rates
 - Network observations on COVID-related technical assistance
 - Kidney patient observations
 - Dialysis supply & staffing shortages

What Else Has the Forum Been Doing?



- The Forum received a \$5000 grant from PCORI to support the dissemination of Evidence Updates related to treating depression in patients with kidney disease. The Forum will complete 3 activities to help promote the PCORI Evidence Updates:
 - 1. <u>Patient-perspective piece</u> summarizing KPAC members' participation in study and their experiences related to mental health and kidney disease.
 - 2. <u>Podcast</u> on the topic of mental health in dialysis patients to bring awareness to the topic and offer resources for patients, including the PCORI Evidence Updates and the KPAC Depression Toolkit.
 - 3. Partnering with the ESRD Networks, the KPAC will host a <u>community webinar</u> on January 5, 2023, on the topic of mental health in dialysis patients, annual depression screening, and treatment options.


