**DESCRIPTION & OUTCOMES:** The Alliant Health Solutions Network Transplant Coalition developed a Kidney Transplant Checklist\* to help patients navigate the transplant process and keep track of all pertinent information as well as to stay on track with important dates and appointments. The checklist is available in both English and Spanish. This checklist is now being included in patient packets at our transplant centers. We disseminated to all our transplant centers, and they have reported that it is a great tool.

**EXPLAIN WHY THE PROJECT/ACTIVITY IS A HIGHLY EFFECTIVE PRACTICE:** This checklist benefits patients/caregivers who have a written road map outlining specific steps to take in preparing for transplant. It also benefits clinic staff, providing quick access to the individual patient's care plan at a glance. These forms can easily be used nationwide. Clinics without a transplant unit can modify the checklist to include referral information.
